GENERAL INFORMATION

SUCCEED[®] is a blend of high quality methylated soybean oil and a superior emulsifier that promotes efficient tank mixing with post-emergence herbicides. **SUCCEED[®]** is designed to replace non-ionic surfactants and crop oil concentrates in liquid spray mixtures. **SUCCEED[®]** is formulated with agriculturally derived soybean oil that improves leaf coverage and absorption under adverse environmental conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add **SUCCEED[®]** to the spray mixture at the rate of 1 to 2 pints per acre. Use the higher end of the rate on hard-to-control weeds or weeds under stress for optimum effectiveness. Always refer to the pesticide label for recommendations and precautions. Add **SUCCEED[®]** last to the tank mixture and provide good agitation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry place. Store only in the original container. Do not store near feed or food or near heat or open flame. Storage between 40°F and 120°F is suggested. If stored below 32°F, **SUCCEED[®]** may become cloudy. Above 32°F it returns to its normal clear fluid state. Triple rinse container and offer for recycling/reconditioning or dispose of at an approved sanitary landfill. Do not reuse empty container.

FIRST AID
