GENERAL INFORMATION

LockDown is a unique micro homogenized, easy to use formulation of ammonium salts and specially designed polymers which acts as a deposition agent, foliar retention agent and canopy penetrating agent.

LockDown improves spray deposition, retention and canopy penetration. **LockDown** also improves pesticide performance by reducing hard water antagonism in the spray tank.

LockDown is formulated for use with herbicides, insecticides and fungicides, unless specifically prohibited by the pesticide label. Users should always check for tank mix compatibility with specific pesticides.

LockDown IMPROVES PERFORMANCE

- Improves spray droplet retention
- Offsets effects of cool weather applications
- Reduces pesticide antagonism caused by water with high mineral contents (Ca, Mg, Na, Fe)
- Increases amount of pesticide delivered to target plants

LockDown may be used with registered products in the following applications: Agriculture, Forestry, Horticulture, Industrial, Non-Cropland, Ornamental, Right-of-Way and Turf.

USE RATES

Ground and Aerial Applications

9 lbs. of **LockDown** per 100 gallons of spray solution.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT - Add **LockDown** to the spray tank first before adding any other tank mix product, unless the tank mix pesticide(s) or additives direct otherwise.

Mixing Order

1. Fill tank 1/2 full of water and begin agitation.
2. Slowly add the required amount of **LockDown** and allow the product to completely dissolve.
3. Continue filling spray tank with water and add the tank mix components as directed on the pesticide label(s).
