GENERAL INFORMATION

Aurora Premium COC is manufactured using highly refined paraffinic base oil with a high quality surfactant that also includes the new advanced integrated antifoaming agent.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Aurora Premium COC is a blend of a highly refined paraffinic mineral oil and surfactant/emulsifier for use with postemergence pesticides to enhance control in crop and noncrop areas.

NOTE: Read and follow the directions for use as recommended on the pesticide label. Aurora Premium COC is an adjuvant to augment the performance of the pesticide it is used with. Specific usage and restrictions contained on the pesticide label have precedence over use rates contained on this label.

The following use rates are considered to be adequate for most applications. Some pesticides may require different rates for optimum effect.

Ground Applications:

Use 1 quart per acre, or 2 to 4 quarts per 100 gallons of spray solution. See specific pesticide label for instructions on the use rate of Aurora Premium COC.

Aerial Application, Low Volume, CDA:

Use 2 to 8 ounces of Aurora Premium COC per acre. Follow the recommendations on the pesticide label if higher rates are required.

Mixing:

Fill spray tank half-full with water. Then add pesticide per label recommendations and continue filling. Add proper amount of Aurora Premium COC last, and continue agitation.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Aurora Premium COC may increase the effectiveness of pesticides. During periods of high temperatures, or extremely humid conditions, some pesticides become more active. It is recommended that a small test area be treated if such conditions prevail. Test areas are also recommended in the treatment of new crop varieties or highly inbred crop lines.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store product in original container. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse container. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry place away from oxidizing agents. Keep packaging closed, securely fastened and upright.

Triple rinse (or equivalent) prior to disposal. Add rinsate to spray tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of properly according to all applicable regulations. If burned, stay out of smoke.

FIRST AID
